Services for the Hearing Impaired

The Death of Christ

In our current series of sermons, "Back to the Basics," we are asking the question, "Is Jesus the Son of God?" Last week we looked at His miracles (Jn. 20: 30-31). In both lessons today we will study some of what the Bible says about the death of Jesus. Does His death confirm His Sonship? The answer is yes.

In this morning's sermon we will briefly remember some of the Old Testament prophecies about the death of Jesus (Ps. 22, Is. 53). Then we will look at one of His parables that prophesied His death (Mt. 21: 33-41). That will be followed by some specific New Testament predictions about His death and what it means. We will see that His death was a sign (Mt. 12: 38-40). His death was a time of great suffering (Mk. 8:31, 9:31, 10:33-34). His death was a sacrifice (Jn. 1:29; 10: 10-11, 15, 17). Finally, His death has eternal significance (Jn. 12: 32-33; 1 Cor. 15: 3).

In tonight's lesson we will continue to study the death of Christ. We will see from the Bible that (1) Christ died, (2) shed His blood, (3) for our sins and (4) our salvation. These are some serious and (I hope) in-depth lessons that are at the very heart of our faith. So far in this series we have studied sin, salvation, love, grace, mercy, the inspiration and authority of the word of God and the miracles of Jesus.

Please be here to study these fundamental lessons with us. Invite others. Future lessons include the resurrection and ascension of Christ, His role in creation, and why He came to earth. Please be with us!
