More on Marriage

Over the past weeks we have discussed topics relating to Christian marriage. We dealt with modesty (June 23), same-sex marriage (June 30), and Christian marriage (July 7). The July 7 sermon dealt with marriage as ordained by God (Gen. 1-2). Today we continue the theme of Christian marriage with a study of Matthew 19 and 1 Corinthians 7. Next Sunday we plan to deal with the topic of Christian morality.

Why are we doing this? Let me share with you some of the reasons by using several quotations. "For the first time in history, western civilization is confronted with the need to define the meaning of the terms marriage and family." "The only way out of our present cultural confusion is a return to a biblical vision of marriage and family." "Marriage and the family are institutions under siege in our world today. With the decline of marriage and the family, our very civilization is in crisis." "The loss of a biblical understanding of marriage and family has led to a general weakening of the institution, even among those who would identify themselves as believing Christians."

Marriage is "a sacred bond between a man and a woman instituted by and publicly entered into before God." The author of the book from which I have quoted says that marriage is supremely about the glory of God. In a Christian marriage God is glorified because marriage is a God-ordained institution.
