I am the good shepherd, The good shepherd gives life to his sheep. John 10:11

Just like most every family, our family would all load up in the car and spend time on a family vacation. We travelled to Disney World, Niagara Falls, Grand Canyon and many other places. Like most kids, we loved a good gift shop t-shirt or souvenir. When it came time for us to leave, my dad would hold up his hand and spin it around in a circle indicating time for us to leave. We would each respond either by going to the door or by holding up our hand with a one indicating we are in line to buy something. Dad was able to keep his flock together with this number system. One finger meant you were waiting and two meant you were walking.

Leading a group of people is not an easy task. Leaders have to find ways to communicate effectively, while providing for the needs of the group they are leading. When Jesus is discussing leadership, He uses the shepherd as the manner in which He would compare himself. A shepherd would spend his time leading the animals to green pastures or to a gentle brook for the sheep to get the nutrients they need for life. Jesus offered His life for us on Calvary so that we could have eternal life. But, there is so much more to the life Jesus lived. Throughout His ministry He was constantly looking out for those around Him to make sure they had the physical things they needed.
