THE NEW MAN

For four Sundays we have studied what it means to be a new man or woman in Christ, based on Colossians 3. Today we focus our attention on Colossians 3: 12-15. We saw last week that the new person in Christ is chosen, holy and beloved. This week we will study the characteristics of the new person described in the verses referred to above.

The new person in Christ is to "put on" several characteristics. He or she is to be characterized by "tender mercies, kindness, humility, meekness and longsuffering." He or she is to bear with one another and forgive one another. He or she is to "above all these things put on love" and "let the peace of God rule in your hearts." Finally, the new man or woman in Christ is to "be thankful."

The Christian is "a new creation" or "a new creature" (2 Cor. 5: 17). He or she has been "born again" (Jn. 3: 3) "of water and the Spirit" (John. 3: 5). The Christian has received "newness of life" (Rom. 6: 4). He or she is a "new man" or woman (Eph. 4: 24; Col. 3: 10).

The new man or woman in Christ is different, even unique. While the word translated "new" in Colossians 3: 10 refers to "that which is recent" (Vine), the word translated "new" in the other passages indicates "new as to form or quality, of different nature from what is contrasted as old" (Vine). A Christian is different; he or she is unique (2 Cor. 6:11-7:1).
