Christian Marriage (4)

Today we continue our study of Christian marriage. In previous lessons we have looked at the foundation for Christian marriage, same-sex marriage, and the confirmation of God's plan for marriage by Jesus. Today we will see the complication that comes when we violate God's plan for marriage (1 Cor. 5:1-6; 6:9-10; 7:1-9).

In 1 Corinthians 5 there is a problem in the church at Corinth. A man has his father's wife. Instead of correcting the problem, the church is puffed up and glorying about the matter. Paul urges the Corinthians to discipline the sinful brother (5: 3-13). In 1 Corinthians 6: 9-10 Paul lists ten kinds of unrighteousness. Three of these deal with sexual sins: fornication, adultery and homosexuality. Paul warns that those who practice such things will not inherit the kingdom of God. Then he urges Christians to "Flee sexual immorality" (6: 18). Why? Because these sins violate God's plan for marriage.

First Corinthians 7 is devoted to the subject of marriage. It states a principle (v. 1) and then a concession (Vs. 2, 6). Verses 3-5 discuss the sexual relationship within marriage, while verses 7-8 deal with celibacy. Verse 9 addresses the problem of self-control, already mentioned in verse 5. Then Paul adds, "For it is better to marry than to burn with passion" (NKJV).

First Corinthians 7 follows what has already been said in the Bible about God's plan for marriage. We are to follow it faithfully to make our marriages what God wants them to be.
