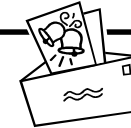

~ The Judgment ~

The Bible clearly teaches that there will be a judgment (Dan. 12: 1-3; Rom. 2: 5-6; 2 Cor. 5: 10; Heb. 9: 27). The judgment scene is described in detail in Rev. 20: 11-15. The scene is set in 20: 11-12. There was "a great white throne and Him who sat upon it." John saw "the dead, the great and the small, standing before the throne" (NASB). The NKJV has "standing before God." It is God who sits on the throne. He will judge the world (Heb. 10: 30; Heb. 12: 23) through Christ (Jn. 5: 22; Acts 10: 42; 2 Cor. 5: 10; 2 Tim. 4: 1).

Notice the situation. As those who had been dead (Jn. 5: 28-29) stood before God "books were opened; and another book was opened, which is the book of life." The "books" must be the books of the Bible, while "the book of life" holds the names of the redeemed (Phil. 4: 3; Rev. 3: 5; Rev. 21: 27). "The dead were judged from the things which were written in the books, according to their deeds."

This passage mentions "the second death" (20: 14), which it identifies as "the lake of fire" (20: 14-15). (See Revelation 2: 11; 21:8; 20: 10; 14: 10-11). That is hell. Who is there? The devil, beast and false prophet (Rev. 19: 20; 20:10), as well as death and Hades (Rev. 20: 14) and the lost (Rev. 20: 15).

Note that "the second death" does not refer to annihilation or cessation of existence, but to eternal separation from God (2 Thess. 1: 9). Hell is not a place with a time limit imposed on it. It is a place of "everlasting punishment" (Mt. 25: 46).
