# JUDGING

Jesus taught the danger of judging. He warned, “Judge not, that you be not judged” (Mt. 7: 1). He emphasized the need to get ourselves right with God before we attempt to judge others (Mt. 7: 1-5). Yet He also taught the need to be always on guard against false teachers and their teaching. “You will know them by their fruits” (Mt. 7: 16). As the beloved Marshall Keeble taught, we may not be judges, but we are “fruit inspectors.”

James addressed the same problem in James 4: 11-12. Verse 11 discusses the danger of judging and speaking against others. “Do not speak evil of one another, brethren.” To speak evil of a brother or sister is to judge that brother or sister. It also makes us a judge of the law. It assumes a right that we do not have.

Verse 12 tells us that the right to judge belongs to God. James says, “There is one Lawgiver, who is able to save and to destroy.” Then he asks, “Who are you to judge another?” Verse 12 speaks of the Judge and Lawgiver. Who is that? God! Only God “is able to save and to destroy.” Only God has both the power and ability to save, to rescue or deliver from sin (Jn. 3: 16-17), and to destroy (Mt. 10: 28).

Our obligation is not to judge, though we must always be on guard against all evil and error (Jude 3). Our duty is to love our neighbors, whoever they may be (Js. 2: 8; Mt. 22: 34-40).
