Bible Bowl Recap

Once again we had a wonderful weekend in Cookeville at Bible Bowl! This was Southern Hills' 13th year to participate. We took 11 teams in Kindergarten through High School. There were over 478 teams for a total of almost 2,000 young people from over 102 congregations.

We had 3 young people receive a medal for participating in Bible Bowl for the past 5 years; **Berkley Rodgers, Tabitha Tucker & Macie Tucker**. In the Young Achievers division **Camille Floyd** received a 2nd place plaque for a score of 91. We had 10 young people receive awards for scoring 90 and above. They were **Aidan Broome (94), Katherine Broome (95), Cayla Floyd (95), Chandler Floyd (95), Kendell Hardison (95), McKenna Hardison (97), Stephanie Hidgon (97), Kayla Reed (92), John Rhodes (96), and Tabitha Tucker (98)**. Also, **Tabitha Tucker** placed 3rd overall for her high score in the senior division.

Southern Hills had 2 teams make it to the "Sweet Sixteen" semi-final round! They were: (junior) **Kendell Hardison, Kayla Reed, John Rhodes & Kelsey Rice**; (senior) **Cayla Floyd, McKenna Hardison, Stephanie Hidgon and Tabitha Tucker**. This is Southern Hills' 7th consecutive year to have teams be a part of the semi-finals! All of our young people worked very hard and are to be commended for their enthusiasm in learning God's Word.

The Judgment

The Bible clearly teaches that there will be a judgment (Heb. 9:27; 2 Cor. 5:10; Rev. 20:11-15). Paul warned Felix and Drusilla about "the judgment to come" (Acts 24:25). Paul was at Corinth when he wrote both 1 and 2 Thessalonians. The second letter followed the first by no more than six months, coming probably in late AD 50 or early 51. The second letter had apparently not been as effective as Paul had hoped it would be in dealing with the continuing confusion about Christ's second coming. So 2 Thessalonians is a letter of encouragement (chapter 1), explanation (chapter 2) and exhortation (chapter 3), all of which God's people need today.

This morning we will study 2 Thessalonians 1:1-10 as we discuss "The Judgment to Come." Tonight our theme is "The Christian's Purpose", based on 2 Thessalonians 1:10-12. You will notice that the first passage (especially verses 7-10) deals with what happens when Christ comes again. The second passage (verses 10-12) deals with what happens now. The verses come in this order because what happens then (the judgment) impacts (or should) what happens now (the way we as Christians live our lives).

The Thessalonians were people of faith, love and patience (1:3-4). They lived with persecutions, tribulations, suffering, affliction, trouble and pressure (1:4-7). In fact, Paul addresses them as "you who are troubled" (v.7). What hope did they have? Where was their comfort? It was in "God's righteous judgment" (v.5) that was to come. There are great lessons here for us. We will look at them today.
