**CROWNS**



At least two kinds of crowns are mentioned in the New Testament. One is the crown of life and the other is the crown of righteousness. The first (the crown of life) is mentioned in two verses (James 1: 12 and Revelation 2: 10). It is “a crown that consists of life” (Tom Holland), a crown of glory, honor, immortality and peace (Rom. 2: 7-10).

The other crown, the one that we will consider today, is the crown of righteousness (2 Tim. 4: 8). It was a crown to which Paul looked forward, as do we. The crown to which the apostle referred was a garland or laurel wreath given to the winner of a race in ancient Greece.

The crown of righteousness is “imperishable” (1 Cor. 9: 25). It is the crown of righteousness that comes from God through Jesus Christ (see Romans) that is to be worn by the redeemed.

When is this crown to be rewarded? “On that day.” What day is that? The day of judgment (Heb. 9: 27; 2 Cor. 5: 10; Rev. 20: 12). Who will give us that crown? “The Lord, the righteous Judge.” Who is that? God (Rom. 2: 5; Rev. 20: 12), through Christ (Rom. 2: 16; 2 Cor. 5: 10). To whom will that crown be given? “To all who have loved His appearing.” Who are those who love his appearing? Those who obey Him (Jn. 14: 15; Mt. 7: 21). Those who are faithful Christians will receive the crown of righteousness. What a joy that will be!
