THE SINLESS CHRIST (2)

Today we continue our study of the sinless Christ. Last Sunday we saw that Jesus understands our problems and that He is eminently qualified to help us. The sermon was based on Hebrews 2: 9-18. He understands us for the reasons stated in those verses. (1) He “was made for a little while lower than the angels” that He by the grace of God “might taste death for everyone” (v. 9).

(2) He was made perfect as the author of our salvation through His sufferings (v. 10). (3) He partook of flesh and blood “that through death He might render powerless him who had the power of death, that is, the devil” (v. 14). (4) “He had to be made like His brethren in all things so that He might become a merciful and faithful high priest. . .to make propitiation for the sins of the people” (v. 17).

Then comes the key verse for last Sunday’s sermon. “For since He Himself was tempted in that which He suffered, He is able to come to the aid of those who are tempted” (v. 18). Not only can Jesus understand and identify with us in our temptations, He understands and identifies with us in all of the trials of life.

Today we will continue this line of thought. Jesus was tempted (Mt. 4: 1-11, 1 Jn. 2: 15-17), yet He was without sin (Heb. 4: 15, 1 Pt. 1: 18-19, 1 Pt. 2: 22). Therefore He is qualified to be our Savior and Lord.
