Deep Trust and Deep Relationships

In church leadership, everything is built on trust. If members doubt a leader's character, competency or compassion, the level of their cooperation may decrease. Passive compliance from members cannot produce the same results as enthusiastic engagement. Passive followers are easily distracted by cares or critics. They are less focused and fervent. Something is draining their precious attention and energy. They spend more time on gossip and personal agendas than group goals. Congregational politics replaces productive teamwork.

Honesty among elders is expected and competency is assumed, but a sense of camaraderie is something you must develop over time. Deep trust occurs as you deepen relationships. It must be experienced rather than demanded. You earn it one caring act at a time. Successful shepherds do not take friendship and fellowship for granted. The best leaders approach it strategically. So how do successful shepherds go about building better relationships? Through home visitation, hospitality, unhurried presence at assemblies, and one-on-one time with workers. This is the work of God's shepherds (John 10:3-4). – Aubrey
