* WE PRESS ON *

Last Sunday we studied Philippians 3, where Paul discussed his past (3:1-6), present (3:7-19) and future (3:20-21). In verse 8 he referred to his zeal as Saul of Tarsus, when he was "a persecutor of the church." We saw several passages that confirm that Saul was indeed a persecutor of God's people.

Then we examined Philippians 3:6, 12 and 14. In the first verse Paul described himself as "a persecutor of the church." In the second verse he wrote, "I press on." In the third verse he repeated "I press on." He used almost exactly the same word in verses 12 and 14 that he used in verse 8. In verses 12 and 14 the words are translated "I press on." In verse 8 the word is translated "persecutor."

What is Paul saying? That he used his zeal as an apostle to "press on" toward his goal of faithful Christian service. Whereas in his earlier life he had used his zeal to persecute the church, he now used his zeal in service to the Lord.

What is the point? The former persecutor had now become the preacher. His zeal was now used in commitment to Christ. The lesson for us is that our zeal must be used to serve the Lord. We must make a commitment to Him and must accept the challenges He puts before us. Challenges, opportunities and responsibilities are given to us by God. We must commit ourselves to Him and His cause.
