### BIBLE BOWL RECAP

Once again we had a great weekend in Cookeville at Bible Bowl! This was Southern Hills' 12th year to participate. We took 8 teams from Kindergarten through High School. There were 492 teams (1,968 young people) from over 100 congregations.

## The Resurrection of Christ

Both the morning and evening sermons today will deal with the theme of the resurrection of Christ. The morning lesson will begin with a brief discussion of some of the Old Testament prophecies that relate to the resurrection of our Lord (Ps. 2:7; Ps. 16:10; Ps. 110:1). This point will be followed by a study of some of our Lord's promises in reference to His resurrection (Jn. 2:18-21; Mt. 16:4; Mt. 20:18-19; Mt. 26:32). These two points will be followed by a third point that will look at some of the biblical proof for the resurrection of Christ (Mt. 28:6-7; Lk. 24:46; Acts 1:3; Acts 2:24, 31-32).

The evening sermon will deal with two things. First we will look at some of the New Testament preaching about the resurrection of Christ (Acts 3:15; Acts 4:10; Acts 4:33; Acts 5:30; Acts 10:40; Acts 17:3, 31). Then we will study the proclamation of the resurrected Christ as set forth in some of the New Testament letters.

These sermons are part of a series that asks the question, "Is Jesus the Son of God?" Those sermons are in turn part of a larger series that is called "Back to the Basics." The larger series will continue for the rest of the year as we discuss such topics as evangelism, the church, heaven, hell, judgment, faith, baptism, music in worship, the Lord's Supper, giving and prayer.

We encourage you to be here for all of the lessons and periods of worship, as well as for our periods of Bible study. It is important to you and your family.
