NO CONDEMNATION IN CHRIST

Romans 8:1 tells us that "There is therefore now no condemnation to those who are in Christ Jesus." Those who are under no condemnation are those "who do not walk according to the flesh, but according to the Spirit" (NKJV). Each word (as always when we study the Bible) is important. The word "therefore" connects what Paul is about to say to what he has said earlier (going all the way back to Romans 1:16).

The word "now" is emphatic. We are no longer under "the law of sin and death" (8:2), which is the law of Moses. We are not under the Law of Moses because it has been fulfilled (Mt. 5:17) and nailed to the cross (Col. 2:14). We are under "the law of the Spirit of life in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 8:2), which is "the law of Christ" (Gal. 6:2).

Obedience to the gospel of Christ has freed us from sin (Rom. 1:16-17). The gospel has freed the Jews from the Law of Moses. The Law, which "was weak through the flesh," could not save men. Why? Because it had to be obeyed completely to save men (Js. 2:10; Gal. 3:10-11). Romans chapters 5-8 teaches that we are freed from death (Rom. 5), sin (Rom. 6), the law (Rom. 7) and condemnation (Rom. 8).

As those who have obeyed the gospel we are to "walk...according to the Spirit" (Rom. 8:1). Our walk is our manner of life. We are to live our lives according to the law of Christ.
