~ Temptation ~

What is temptation? It is "the act of tempting or the state of being tempted, especially to evil" (Webster). To tempt is "to entice to do wrong by promise of pleasure or gain" (Webster). Temptation, according to Vine, can mean trials "definitely designed to lead to wrong doing." The word tempt can include "temptations to sin" (Vine). In this article and today's sermons we are using the words tempt and temptation in this sense.

A nation or an army must always be on guard against attacks from without or within. At the moment we least expect it, from the most unexpected point an attack may come. Paul applied this same thought to the church. The church must always be on guard against attacks from without and within (Acts 20: 28-30).

The same thought also applies to individual Christians. Attacks can come to us from without or within. They always ultimately come from Satan. Satan attacks Christians at their weakest points. This is the warning in James 1: 12-16. As we study James 1 we note the use of two words: trials and temptations. Though both words translate the same Greek word, the two things are not the same. James 1: 1-12 is dealing with trials. James 1: 13-15 is dealing with temptations. Today we are dealing with temptations. As Jesus was tempted, so are we. How do we deal with temptation?
