The Judgment of God

In 2 Thessalonians 1:7-10 Paul describes "God's righteous judgment" (1:5 NASB). The passage answers several questions about "the judgment to come" (Acts 24:25). The first question is "Who will be revealed?" The answer is "the Lord Jesus" (1:7). Who and what will accompany Him? "His mighty angels" and "flaming fire." Second, "Why will He be revealed?" To deal out "retribution to those who do not know God and to those who do not obey the gospel of our Lord Jesus" (1:8). Retribution is punishment or vengeance. It is not human revenge, but divine justice (Rom. 12:19; Deut. 32:35; Heb. 12:29). It will be retribution to two groups: those who do not know God and those who do not obey the gospel.

Third, "What will happen when He is revealed?" The lost will "pay the penalty of eternal destruction away from the presence of the Lord and from the glory of His power" (1:9). Fourth, "When will He be revealed?" The day of the Lord's return is not revealed in the Bible. Even Jesus did not know that time (Mt. 24:36). But at that time He will come "to be glorified in His saints on that day, and to be marveled at among all who have believed" (1:10).

When the Lord comes the dead will be raised (Jn. 5:28-29). "Those who have fallen asleep in Jesus" (1 Th. 4:14) will be raised to eternal life and those who have done evil to everlasting punishment (Jn. 5:29; Mt. 25:46).
