REPENTANCE

What is repentance? It is a change of heart, mind, will and attitude in reference to sin that leads to and results in a change or reformation of the life. Repentance is the change of heart, mind, will and attitude toward sin and the sinful way of life. The result of repentance is the reformation of life.

The Bible emphasizes the necessity of repentance. Both Jesus and John the Baptist said, "Repent, for the kingdom of heaven is at hand!" (Mt. 3: 2; Mt. 4: 17) Jesus said, "Unless you repent you will all likewise perish" (Lk. 13: 3, 5). Before His ascension Jesus added that "repentance and remission of sins should be preached in His name to all the nations" (Lk. 24: 47).

Peter by inspiration told his Pentecost audience to "Repent and let everyone of you be baptized in the name of Jesus Christ for the remission of sins" (Acts 2: 38). Peter later wrote that God is "not willing that any should perish but that all should come to repentance" (2 Pt. 3: 9).

Paul told the Athenians, "Truly, these times of ignorance God overlooked, but now commands all men everywhere to repent" (Acts 17: 30). He wrote, "Godly sorrow produces repentance leading to salvation, not to be regretted; but the sorrow of the world produces death" (2 Cor. 7: 10).

Repentance includes a recognition of our sins, a rejection of the sinful way of life, a renunciation of that way of life, and a return to God. Repentance is essention to salvation.
