Jesus' Mission and Message

In recent sermons in our series "Meet the Master" we have done exactly that. We met the Person, the Master Jesus Christ, the Son of God (Mk. 1:1). Then we looked at the beginning of Mark's gospel. He began with the prophets (Mk. 1:2-3). This was followed by the introduction of the preacher, John the Baptist, and his work. (Mk. 1:4-8). That was followed by sermons on "The Master's Baptism" (Mk. 1:9), "The Master Is God's Son" (Mk. 1:10-11), and "The Master Meets Satan" (Mk. 1:12-13). Today our theme is "The Master's Mission and Message" (Mk. 1:14-15).

What was Jesus' mission? "Jesus came to Galilee, preaching the gospel of the kingdom of God" (Mk. 1:14 NKJV). His mission was to preach. The word means to herald, announce or proclaim. What was He preaching? "The gospel." What is the gospel? It is God's "good news" of His Son. It is "of God." The word of means "from." It is the good news from God. He is its source and origin.

What was Jesus' message? His message was "the gospel of God" (Mk. 1:14). What were its contents? (1) "The time is fulfilled." (2) It was "of the kingdom of God." (3) The kingdom was "at hand" or "near." The kingdom, which had not been established by Acts 1:6-8, was established in Acts 2. The kingdom is the church. By Colossians 1:13 the kingdom is spoken of as a present reality.

What did Jesus tell people to do? (1) They were to "repent." (2) They were to "believe in the gospel." What is the message for men today? That those who are lost must obey the gospel to be saved. Have you obeyed the gospel?
