### "SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"



## MOTHERS



Paul and Silas were on their second missionary journey. They stopped at Lystra, an obscure town that Paul had visited on his first missionary journey. While the work at Lystra had not been altogether productive, a church was established there (Acts 14: 21-23). In that church there was a young convert named Timothy (Acts 16: 1), who was "the son of a certain Jewish woman who believed, but his father was a Greek."

We later learn that Timothy's mother was named Eunice, while his grandmother was Lois (2 Tim. 1:5). Timothy was well spoken of by the brethren at both Lystra and Iconium (Acts 16: 2). Paul recruited Timothy to accompany him on the second missionary journey. Paul later called Timothy "a true son in the faith" (1 Tim. 1:2) and "a beloved son" (2 Tim. 1:2).

On this Mother's Day we will study 2 Tim. 3: 14-17, a very important passage for many reasons. Today we will draw from it some lessons about mothers and their children. What are these lessons? First, we must teach our children God's will so they can continue in it (3:14). Second, we must teach them well enough that they are convinced that God's word is truth (Jn. 17:17).

Third, we must begin teaching our children God's word as early as possible in their lives, even from earliest childhood (3:15). Fourth, this is imperative because God's inspired word will help our children grow into mature Christians because the word of God will make them complete (3:16-17). So the four key words for this lesson are Continue, Convince, Childhood and Complete. If mothers heed these words they will bring their children up in the training and admonition of the Lord (Eph. 6:4).
