~ Messages From Mark ~

So far in our messages from Mark we have seen that Mark's gospel account is about "Jesus Christ, the Son of God" (1: 1). The coming of Jesus was prophesied (1: 2-3). His way was prepared by the prophet and preacher, John the Baptist (1: 4-8). Jesus was baptized by John (1: 9-10) and proclaimed by God (1: 10-11). Then He was tempted by Satan (1: 12-13), after which He preached "the gospel of the kingdom of God" (1: 14-15). Then He called four of His disciples to follow Him (1: 16-20).

Today we begin a look at a section within a section as we study "The Master and His Miracles" (1: 21- 2: 12). He cast out an unclean spirit (1: 21-28), healed Peter's mother-in-law (1: 29-31), healed many others and drove demons out of many (1: 32-34), cleansed a leper (1: 40-45) and forgave and healed a paralytic (2: 1-12).

What do these miracles do? First, they help people with needs: a man possessed by an unclean spirit, a woman with "a high fever" (Lk. 4: 38), many others who were sick or possessed by demons, a leper and a paralytic. Second, they confirm that He truly is "Jesus Christ, the Son of God" (1: 1).

Why is that important? Because the pluralistic postmodern view is that Jesus is just one Savior among many, if He is a Savior at all. Many put Him on a level with other religious figures: Mohammed, Buddha and a host of others. But according to their view He is at best only one Savior among several. How different that is from what Jesus said: "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me" (Jn. 14: 6).
