A BLESSED PEOPLE

Christians are a blessed people (Matthew 5:1-12). Why? Because of our relationship to God through Jesus Christ (John 14:6). We are "a chosen generation, a royal priesthood, a holy nation, His own special people" (1 Peter 2:9). What is our purpose? "That you may proclaim the praises of Him who called you out of darkness into His marvelous light."

We became Christians when we obeyed the gospel (Romans 1:16-17). This was done by faith (Hebrews 11:6), repentance (Acts 17:30), confession (Romans 10:10) and baptism by immersion in order to receive the remission of sins (Acts 2:38). We were then added to the Lord's church (Acts 2:47).

The church consists of the "called out." The called out are added to Christ's body, which is the church (Ephesians 1:22-23; Ephesians 5:23; Colossians 1:18). Each of us is a member of His body. We have different talents and abilities, but we all contribute these to the growth and strengthening of the body (1 Corinthians 12:12-27).

As members of Christ's body we are to function as salt, light and leaven (Matthew 5:13-16; Matthew 13:33). We are to have a positive influence for Christ on the world in which we live. This means that we are to live like Christ and for Christ at all times and in all ways. We are to present our bodies as "a living sacrifice, holy, acceptable to God, which is your reasonable service" (Romans. 12:1). We are not to "be conformed to this world," but we are to be transformed by the renewing of our minds (Romans 12:2).
