It was early Friday morning. April 3, A.D.33. After Jesus' arrest He had endured an informal hearing before Annas, the former high priest. That was followed by a more formal—but illegal—trial before Caiaphas, the reigning high priest and son-in-law of Annas. The purpose was to determine the charge to be placed against Jesus. The charge was blasphemy (Matthew 26:25). Therefore, the group determined that Jesus was “deserving of death” (Matthew 26:22).

Then his accusers “bound Jesus, led Him away, and delivered Him to Pontius Pilate, the governor” (Matthew 27:2). Here, however, the charge was not blasphemy, but treason (Luke 23:1-2). Pilate, however, knew that Jesus had done nothing worthy of death.

So, Pilate sent Jesus to Herod, the tetrarch of Galilee. Herod hoped to see Jesus perform a miracle, but Jesus refused. So, Herod “treated Him with contempt and mocked Him, arrayed Him in a gorgeous robe, and sent Him back to Pilate (Luke 23:1-12).

Pilate's wife warned Pilate to “have nothing to do with this just man” (Matthew 27:19). So, Pilate, still seeking a way out of his dilemma, offered to release either Jesus or Barabbas to the crowd. They chose Barabbas.

So, Pilate, in one last effort to justify himself, sought to wash his hands of the situation saying. “I am innocent of the blood of this just person. You see to it.” (Matthew 27:24).

“So, he delivered Him to them to be crucified.” (John 19:16).
