~~ PREACHING ~~

The sermon last Sunday was on the place, power and purpose of preaching. It emphasized the fact that preaching is one of the acts of worship. In 2 Timothy 4: 1-5 Paul encouraged Timothy in regard to preaching. The passage can be divided into two parts: the Charge (vs. 1-2) and the Challenge (vs. 3-5).

Paul charged Timothy "before God and the Lord Jesus Christ" to "Preach the word!" The word preach means to herald or proclaim. What was Timothy to proclaim? The word of God, the Bible. Why? Because it is "given by inspiration of God" (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). Because the Bible is God's inspired word, it is central to both our preaching and our worship. That is the place of preaching.

There is power in preaching God's word (Rom. 1: 16-17). The word convinces (proves), rebukes (corrects, blames) and exhorts (encourages). Preaching is to be done "in season and out of season," that is, whenever the opportunity arises. As A. T. Robertson said, we are to "stick to it."

Why are we to continue to preach God's word? Because "the time will come when they will not endure sound doctrine." It is here! Those who have itching ears "will turn their ears away from the truth, and be turned aside to fables." They will not bear with the preaching of "sound doctrine" or "healthy teaching."

What are faithful preachers to do? "Be watchful in all things, endure afflictions, do the work of an evangelist, fulfill your ministry." Preach the word!
