* God Has Spoken *

Long ago (approximately 750 B.C.) the Old Testament prophet Isaiah wrote, "Hear, O heavens, and give ear, O earth! For the Lord has spoken" (Is. 1:2, NKJV). Many years later the author of Hebrews wrote, "God, who at various times and in various ways spoke in time past to the fathers by the prophets, has in these last days spoken to us in His Son" (Heb. 1: 1-2). Paul and the other New Testament preachers preached "the word of His grace" (Acts 20:32). They did not shun "to declare to you the whole counsel of God" (Acts 20:27). Preachers today must do the same.

Today, as we study "the word of His grace," we will look at Titus 2:11-14. Our theme is "The Grace of God." We will see that (1) "the grace of God that brings salvation has appeared to all men" (2:11). We will see that (2) the grace of God teaches us (2:12). Then we will note that (3) the grace of God gives us "blessed hope" (2:13). Finally (4) the grace of God redeems us (2:14).

All who are saved will be saved by the grace of God (Eph. 2:5, 8-10). However, the grace of God does not free us from our obligation to do the will of God (Rom. 5:20-6:4). We must obey God's word (Mt. 7:13-14, 21, 24-27). We are not saved by "grace only," as some say; we are saved by grace through faith (Eph. 2:8). Grace is God's part; faith is our part.
