Paul often called on people to follow him (1 Corinthians 4.16; Philippians 3.17; 2 Thessalonians 3.7, 9). However, the goal was never self-promotion. He used His example to help people know and follow Christ. Paul told the Thessalonians, "And you became imitators of us and of the Lord, for you received the word in much affliction, with the joy of the Holy Spirit" (1 Thessalonians 1.6). Paul modeled joy in adversity to show people the power faith in Christ afforded him for daily living. When a person has joy in affliction, he is imitating Christ. Paul's philosophy was simple. He said, "For me to live is Christ" (Philippians 1.21). When you follow someone who is faithfully following Christ, you become like Christ. You possess the mind of Christ and, thus, the manner of Christ (Philippians 2.5). This morning, we will take a look at the inspiring transformation of Saul of Tarsus into the Apostle Paul. The same power that changed Paul will work in your life, your marriage, your career. That is the power of the gospel. — Aubrey
