Doers of the Word

James 1: 22-25 emphasizes the importance of the word of God. We are to “be doers of the word, and not hearers only” (v. 22). Why? The word is that important because it comes to us from God (2 Tim. 3: 16-17). The inspired word applies to us because it guides and directs our lives in the way God wants us to live. It produces the spiritual maturity that God wants us to have (Eph. 4: 13; 2 Pt. 3: 18).

To be doers of the word is to live according to the word (Ps. 119: 105). Notice that there is a distinction between simply hearing and hearing and doing. We are not to be hearers only. If that is all we are we are deceiving ourselves. We are not deceiving God, only ourselves.

To be non-doers is to be hearers only. It is like a person looking into a first century mirror (unlike modern mirrors) and going away and immediately forgetting what he or she looks like. It is to see only “darkly” (1 Cor. 13: 12).

What is a doer of the word like? What does he or she do? He or she “looks into the perfect law of liberty” (v. 25). That is the word of God (vs. 18, 21). God’s word is “perfect” (1 Cor. 13: 10; Jn. 8: 32). And we must continue in it. Such a person is “not a forgetful hearer but a doer of the work.” He or she builds his or her life on God’s word (Mt. 7: 24-27).
