Who is Jesus?

Jesus asked the Pharisees, "What do you think about the Christ, whose son is He?" (Matthew 22:42). That is the question we are asking today. Actually we are asking two questions. In the morning sermon the question is "Who is Jesus"? In the evening sermon the question will be "Why is Jesus important?"

Both of these are fundamental questions. You have heard them discussed before, but it never hurts to be reminded again of the answers. This morning's sermon will discuss two points. First, Jesus is the Son of God. Second, Jesus is the Savior of the world. Many more sermons could be preached on these points. But these two are at least a good starting point.

The evening sermon will suggest several reasons as to why Jesus is important. These include His Virgin birth, sinless life, miracles, teachings, death, resurrection, and ascension. Each of these will be discussed briefly. The auditorium Bible class lesson will examine the matter of prophecy and fulfillment and how this relates to Jesus and His importance. We will begin with the prophecy in Numbers 21:4-9. This will be followed by an analysis of the fulfillment of that prophecy in John 3:14-17.

Please plan to be with us to study these lessons. Again, they are basic, but they are also extremely important. Our faith is being challenged on every hand. We must be prepared for these constant and continuing assaults. We prepare for them by knowing and living by God's Word. ~ Dan Cottrell
