**KINDNESS**

What is kindness? Why is it important? The word refers to "goodness of heart." The Bible teaches that we are to "Be kind to one another" (Eph. 4:32). Jesus said of God that "He Himself is kind" (Lk. 6:35; Eph. 2:7). If our Father is kind to us, should we not be kind to each other? The Bible says that "love is kind" (1 Cor. 13:4).

God's "merciful kindness" is great toward us (Ps. 117:2). Proverbs 19:22 says, "What is desired in a man is kindness." It is said of the worthy woman that "on her tongue is the law of kindness" (Pr. 31:26). "Kindness" is listed as a fruit of the Spirit (Gal. 5:22). We are to "put on...kindness" (Col. 3:12). Christians are to be characterized by "brotherly kindness" (2 Pt. 1:7).

Kindness is characteristic of Christians. It begins in, and comes from, a heart of love. God loves us; we love God; we are to love each other (1 Jn. 4:7-21). Love begins in our hearts. "Keep your heart with all diligence, For out of it spring the issues of life" (Pr. 4:23 NKJB). If our heart is not right, our life cannot be right.

And the heart controls the tongue. Jesus said, "It is not what enters into the mouth that defiles the man, but what proceeds out of the mouth, this defiles the man" (Mt. 15:11). Why? Because "the things that proceed out of the mouth come from the heart, and those defile the man" (Mt. 15:18). Kindness comes from our hearts.
