Claims of the Christ (2)

Last week we looked at Jesus' statement, "I am the light of the world" (Jn. 8:12). We saw how that claim relates back to God's statement to Moses when He said, "I AM WHO I AM" (Ex. 3: 13-14). Jesus was making a conscious connection between Himself and God because He is God (Phil. 2: 5-11; Jn. 1: 1-18; 1 Tim. 3: 16).

Today we look at the claims of Jesus in John 8: 13-30. (1) His witness is true because He know where He came from and where He was going (Jn. 8: 14). (2) His judgment is true because He was not alone, He was with the Father and the Father was with Him (8: 16). (3) The Father bears witness of Him (8: 18). (4) If they knew Him they would know the Father (8: 10; 14: 9). (5) He is from above and not of this world (8: 23).

(6) Not to believe in Him is to die in our sins (8: 24). (7) He speaks what He heard from the Father (8: 26). (8) He could do nothing of Himself, but as the Father taught Him (8: 28). (9) The Father who sent Him was with Him (8: 29). (10) When He was lifted up on the cross "then you will know that I am He" (8: 28).

Here are ten claims, all confirmed by God's word. Finally, there was the result. "As He spoke these words, many believed in Him" (8: 30). They believed in Him through His word, as men must today (Rom. 10: 17; Jn. 6: 63; Jn. 12: 48).
