~ TRUTH ~

Two thousand years ago a perplexed Pontius Pilate asked Jesus, "What is truth?" (Jn. 18: 38). Several dictionary and lexicon definitions help us answer that question. Truth is that which is true, right, proper, correct and factual. It is that which conforms with fact and reality, that which is verifiable. It is that which comes from God and is taught in His word (Jn. 17: 17). It is that which can be known (Ps. 119:105; Jn. 16: 13; 2 Tim. 2: 2, 15).

One of the great emphases of the Gospel of John is truth. Jesus embodied truth (1: 14). Truth comes through Him (1: 17). He told the truth (8: 40, 45, 46). He is the truth (14: 6). His word is truth (17: 17, 19). He bears witness to the truth (18: 37). His Holy Spirit guides us into all truth (16: 13).

John 8: 31-32 states three very important things. First, there is the DEFINITION. His word is truth. We must know the truth to abide in His word. Second, there is the ACTION. What does truth do? It makes us free. From what? Sin! Third, there is the CONDITION. We are free IF we abide in His word. To abide is to remain. We must remain faithful to Him. How? By obeying His word. Then we truly are His disciples.

Many today deny that there is any such thing as absolute truth. The Bible teaches otherwise. God's word is truth. It is the truth that makes us free. We thank God for His truth!
