~ Miracles ~

C.S. Lewis defined a miracle as "an interference with nature by supernatural powers." Someone else defined a miracle as "God's intervention in the world in extraordinary ways for His purposes." The Bible stated the purpose of the miracles of Jesus in John 20: 30-31. "Therefore many other signs Jesus also performed in the presence of the disciples, which are not written in this book; but these have been written so that you may believe that Jesus is the Christ, the Son of God; and that believing you may have life in His name."

Over the past several Sundays most of our sermons have been based on the first chapter of the gospel of Mark. Two weeks ago we studied the first of Jesus' miracles recorded by Mark, that of driving an unclean spirit out of a man (Mk. 1: 21-28). Last Sunday night we looked at the miracle in which Jesus healed Simon Peter's mother-in-law.

Today both sermons will be devoted to the next miracles of Jesus recorded by Mark. This morning we will study "The Master and His Miracles (III)", based on Mark 1: 32-39. Tonight we will look at "The Master and His Miracles (IV)", based on Mark 1: 40-45.

Jesus performed miracles for two reasons. One was His compassion on those with needs (Mk. 1: 41). The other, as noted above, was to confirm the fact that He is "Jesus Christ, the Son of God," as Mark affirmed in the very first verse of his gospel account. He is the Messiah, the Son of God, the Savior of the world, and no one comes to God except through Him (Jn. 14: 6).
