Today we celebrate our twenty-second anniversary. On January 14, 1986, three families met to discuss the idea of starting a new congregation of the Lord's church in this area. Forty people gathered on the first Sunday night in June of that year in a basement meeting room of the First Tennessee Bank on the square in downtown Franklin. I was privileged to be the speaker that evening. Some of you were present.

By September of 1986 the new church was meeting for all services at the bank. One year later the church bought property on the Goose Creek By-Pass and converted the garage into a meetinghouse. The first meeting there was November 29, 1987. We moved into the present auditorium on November 3, 1993. The new addition was completed in 2001.

We look forward to continuing by God's grace to glorify Him and His Son and to bringing the lost to Christ.
