## ~ A Great High Priest ~

Hebrews 4: 14-16 teaches four important facts about Jesus. First, He is "a great high priest." He is "Jesus, the Son of God." He "has passed through the heavens." Therefore, as the writer says, "Let us hold fast our confession." Note that these verses in Hebrews are not the first place in the letter where Jesus has been referred to as our High Priest. (See Hebrews 2:17 and 3:1.)

Second, Jesus is a sympathetic High Priest (4:15). He can and does "sympathize with our weaknesses." Why? Because He is "One who has been tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin." He not only "feels for us" in our weaknesses and suffering, He makes them His own. What are our weaknesses? Things that cause us to sin.

Third, Jesus is a sinless High Priest (4:15). He was "tempted in all things as we are, yet without sin." Satan tempted Jesus (Mt. 4:1-11.) He was tempted to avoid the "cup" that He had to endure to the point that He prayed that it might pass from Him (Mt. 26:39). He was tempted "in all things as we are." Therefore, He completely understands us.

Fourth, Jesus is a saving High Priest (4:16). Therefore, we can "draw near with confidence to the throne of grace, so that we may receive mercy and find grace to help in time of need." Jesus Christ is our great High Priest.
