## \* SERMON SERIES \*

We have just completed a series of sermons on the Gospel of Mark. It was an on-again, off-again series that took one and one-half years. I hope it was a blessing to your life; I know it was to mine. Today we begin two new series of sermons. The Sunday morning series deals with salvation. The topics are What Is Salvation?, Salvation From Sin, What Does It Mean To Be Lost?, Why Is Salvation Important?, and How Are We Saved? The series will be interrupted on May 13 for our annual Mother's Day sermon.

Sunday night we will begin a new series of sermons on First Peter. Many years ago I preached a series of sermons from that letter under the title "Hang In There!" This, however, is an altogether different series of lessons. The sermon this Sunday night is "Four Facts of Faith," based on 1 Peter 1: 1-2. The First Peter sermons will be expository in nature. That means we will "unpack" the text to get its meaning. This includes both definition and exposition of the text. That is followed by illustration of what the text says. Most of the illustrations (but not all) will come from the Bible. That in turn is followed by application, where we ask, "What does this mean to us?"

I hope you will be here for these lessons. Please bring your Bible with you. We will try our best "to feed the church of God" (Acts 20: 28 KJV). (Read Psalm 119: 105; John 17: 17; Psalm 1:2).
