Rightly Dividing the Word of Truth

When Paul wrote to Timothy he said “**Be diligent to present yourself approved to God, a worker who does not need to be ashamed, rightly dividing the word of truth**” (II Timothy 2:15). Let me point out four important lessons from this passage. **First**, if it is possible to rightly divide the word of truth then it is also possible to wrongly divide it. **Second**, we need to be diligent to make sure we rightly divide it. **Third**, those who are diligent to make sure they rightly divide the word of truth are approved by God. The opposite would also be true that if we are not diligent in our Bible study and thus we wrongly divide the word of truth then we will not be approved of by God. **Fourth**, those who are not diligent to rightly divide the word of truth, Paul says, should be ashamed. Let us make sure that we take this verse to heart.
