A SPIRITUAL CHECKLIST

Psalm 15, written by David, asks an important question and gives an important answer. The question is, "Lord, who may abide in Your tabernacle? Who may dwell in Your holy hill?" (v. 1). The answer is given in the next four verses. There are eleven parts to this spiritual checklist. Six are positive and five are negative.

Verse two gives three of the positive qualifications. (1) The person walks uprightly or with integrity. (2) He works righteousness. (3) He speaks truth in his heart. He obeys God's will, lives a righteous life and speaks the truths of God's word.

Verse three lists three negative qualifications. (1) Such a person is not to backbite or slander with his tongue. (See Js. 1: 26; Js. 3: 1-12; Prov. 6: 17, 19; Rev. 21: 8). (2) He does not do evil to his neighbor. (3) He does not listen to reproaches made against his friends. Verse four gives three more positive parts of the checklist. (1) This person despises evil, (2) honors those who fear the Lord, and (3) keeps his word.

Verse five condemns usury or exorbitant interest to a fellow Israelite. (See Ex. 22:25-27; Lev. 25:36-37; Dt. 23: 19-20; Ezek. 18: 8; Lk. 6: 34-35). It also says that such a person does not take bribes. Finally, David concludes, "He who does these things shall not be moved." He maintains faithful fellowship with God. While this is a part of the old covenant, these principles are also taught in the new covenant.
