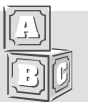

~ Love For The Lost ~

The Lord's church must be in the business of winning souls to Christ. We will never be successful in this endeavor until and unless we develop a deep and sincere love for the lost. The Bible teaches a great deal about the importance of leading people to Christ (Dan.12: 1-3; Pr. 11: 30; Js. 5: 19-20). Why is love for the lost so important?

First, love for the lost is important because God loves the lost. That is why He gave His Son to die on the cross (Jn. 3: 16-17; 1 Jn. 4: 9-10). Second, love for the lost is important because we love God and we share His love for lost souls (Jn. 14: 15; Mt. 28: 18-20). Third, we love lost souls because we are Christians, a word which describes one who is of or like Christ. Jesus came to "seek and save the lost" (Lk. 19: 10). In fact, He "came to give His life a ransom for many" (Mk. 10: 45). Christians should love lost souls as He did.

Bringing the lost to Christ brings joy to God (Lk. 15: 7, 10). It also brings joy to the soul winner (Js. 5: 19-20). It likewise brings joy to the Lord's church (Acts 15: 3). And it certainly brings joy to the souls that are led to the Lord (Acts 8: 39).

A lady wrote a letter to those who had led her and her family to Christ. And it all began, she said, with "a knock on the door." Let's knock on some doors and lead souls to Christ!
