## HAPPY MOTHER'S DAY!

It is said that "the hand that rocks the cradle rules the world." Someone else said, "God could not be everywhere, so He made mothers." {See Ephesians 4:6.} The best description of a wife and mother is found in Proverbs 31:10-31. Note that, while the words are from King Lemuel, they were taught to him by his mother (Proverbs 31:1). How appropriate is that!

Proverbs 31 refers to several characteristics of a godly wife and mother. She is virtuous, valuable and trustworthy. She brings her family honor, she works hard, and is a good businesswoman. She is strong, benevolent, wise, kind and watchful, but never idle. Note how precious such a wife and mother is to her family. "Her children rise up and call her blessed. Her husband also, and he praises her." And, above all else, "She is a woman who fears the Lord."

The Bible contains many examples of godly mothers. Two of them are Mary, the mother of Jesus, and Hannah, the mother of Samuel. Hannah "prayed to the Lord." She vowed to dedicate her child to God if God would give her a child. God chose Mary to be the mother of our Lord. Her story is told in the first two chapters of Luke. Mary gave herself to the will of God (Lk. 1:38). We should honor our mothers every day, but we honor them in a special way on this their day. Happy Mother's Day, mom!
