## ~ The Gospel of Christ ~

Why do men need to hear, believe and obey the gospel of Christ?  
(1) Because the gospel is the power of God unto salvation (Rom. 1: 16).  
(2) Because faith comes by hearing the word of God (Rom. 10: 17).  
(3) Because the gospel is the means by which we are saved (1 Cor. 15: 2).  
(4) Because the gospel tells us about the death, burial and resurrection of Christ (1 Cor. 15: 3-4). (5) Because we must obey the gospel if we want to be saved (Mk. 16: 15-16; 2 Thess. 1: 8; 1 Pt. 4: 17). (6) Because one day we will die (Heb. 9: 27). (7) Because we must face God in judgment (Heb. 9: 27; Rev. 20: 11-15). (8) Because our eternal destiny depends on gospel obedience (Mk. 16: 16). Are these not reasons enough?

We are deeply and rightfully concerned about those who have not obeyed the gospel. Why have you not? Why do you put off the most important decision of your life? No one can go to heaven except through Jesus Christ (Jn. 14: 6) and obedience to His gospel. Primary obedience is to be followed by a faithful Christian life (Mt. 5: 13-16). Why have you not obeyed the gospel of the Lord?

What must you do to obey the gospel? Hear (Rom. 10: 17), believe (Heb. 11: 6), repent of past sins (Lk. 13: 1-5), confess the name of Christ (Rom. 10: 10) and be immersed for the remission of your sins (Acts 2: 38). Why not do that today? Why do you wait? "Behold, now is the accepted time; behold, now is the day of salvation" (2 Cor. 6: 2).
