Love the People

I would like to briefly turn your attention to the biblical account of Jonah. God told one of His prophets, Jonah, to preach to Nineveh because their wickedness was great (Jonah 1:2). Yet, Jonah did not like the Ninevites and so he did not want them to be forgiven. Therefore, he tried to run from God, however, God made him obey. When Jonah finally preached to those of Nineveh they repented, and God forgave them. This caused Jonah to throw himself what we might call a “pity party”. He sat underneath a plant that God prepared for him to have shade; however, the next day God caused that plant to wither. This made Jonah very angry. Listen to Jonah 4:10, 11 **“But the LORD said, ‘You have had pity on the plant for which you have not labored, nor made it grow, which came up in a night and perished in a night. And should I not pity Nineveh, that great city, in which are more than one hundred and twenty thousand persons.’”** This passage should always serve as an important reminder for us. Let us recognize God’s love for the people of this world and let us share in that love.
