## A MEMORIAL TO CHRIST

Monday is Memorial Day, a day set aside to honor American servicemen and women who gave their lives for our country. Today is memorial day, too. It is "the first day of the week" (Acts 20:7), the day on which the Lord's church observes the Lord's Supper, a memorial feast that honors our Lord.

Jesus instituted the Lord's Supper (Mt. 26:26-28) "in the night in which He was betrayed" (1 Cor. 11:23). The Lord's church observed the Supper from the very first of its existence (Acts 2: 42). It observed the Supper "on the first day of the week" (Acts 20:7). That is why the New Testament church today observes the Lord's Supper on the first day of every week.

The Holy Spirit through the Apostle Paul gave us divine guidelines for the proper observance of the Lord's supper (1 Cor. 11: 23-34). What are those guidelines? First, notice the problem (17-22). There were divisions and factions that made it impossible to observe the Supper properly.

Second, there was a proper procedure for observing the Supper (23-25). Third, there was a proper purpose for the Supper (26). Fourth, there was a precept (27-34) that condemned unworthy participation (27) and commanded examination and worthy participation (28-34).

The Lord's Supper looks four ways: backward (24-25), forward (26), outward (26) and inward (28). The Lord's Supper is an important-even vital-part of Christian worship.
