God has given us guidelines for our giving in the Corinthian letters. In 1 Corinthians 16: 2 we are to (1) "On the first day of the week" (2) "lay something aside" (3) as we have been "prospered".

Second Corinthians 8: 1 - 9: 15 lists several guidelines. The theme of these chapters is liberality (8: 2-3; 9: 11, 13). We must first give ourselves (8: 5) as we follow the example of Christ (8: 9). We must have "a willing mind" (8: 12). We must give generously (9: 5), bountifully (9: 6), purposefully (9: 7) and cheerfully (9: 7). These are God's guidelines for giving.

This morning's sermon is "A Review and Preview." First we will review our work in 2010, then we will preview the upcoming 2011. Our purpose is to encourage your spiritual growth (Eph. 4: 13; 2 Pet. 3: 18). Our spiritual growth comes only by obedience to God and His word. Have a happy new year in growth and service in the kingdom of God.
