* Faithful Fathers *

It has been said that the church is always only one generation away from apostasy or extinction. The same can be said of families. We must do everything we can to save the family from attacks on it. The only way to save the family is to make sure that the family is guided by God's word. This means that the family needs to have godly mothers and faithful fathers. We discussed godly mothers on Mother's Day. Today we turn our attention to faithful fathers. How can fathers be faithful?

First, fathers must be faithful in word. They must be faithful to God's word (Pr. 22:6) and they must be faithful to God's word in what they say. This includes talking properly, by which we mean using only godly language (Col. 3:8; Eph. 4:29). Fathers must also be faithful in word by talking to their children about God (Deut. 6:1-9).

Second, fathers must be faithful in spending time with their children. This means devoting your time and attention to the things that are important to your children, whether it is playing ball with your son or having a tea party with your daughter.

Third, fathers must be faithful in living Christian lives (Gen. 18:19). How we live our lives has a major impact on our children and is reflected in our children. We must teach by word and be a proper example by life. A faithful father must provide Christian leadership for his family.
