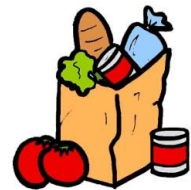

The Role of Women

Last Sunday night and tonight I have preached and will preach on "The Role of Women in the Church." While the ancient world had a low view of women, the opposite is true of Jesus and the New Testament. Jesus, for example, honored women and their place in God's plan in the world, the nation, the home and the church. Bible scholar Wayne Jackson makes the point.

"The NT abounds with examples of godly women who, consistent with their assigned roles, served their Master with dignity and honor. . .God's women make a vital contribution to the kingdom of Christ on earth. Whether they are continuing steadfastly in prayer, doing good works, showing hospitality, teaching the word in harmony with divine authority, being good wives, rearing children, or doing various other commendable tasks, let us 'rise up and call them blessed'."
