In John 5 we read of a time when Jesus healed a man who had not walked in 38 years. After the miracle, the Jews approached Jesus because he healed the man on the Sabbath. 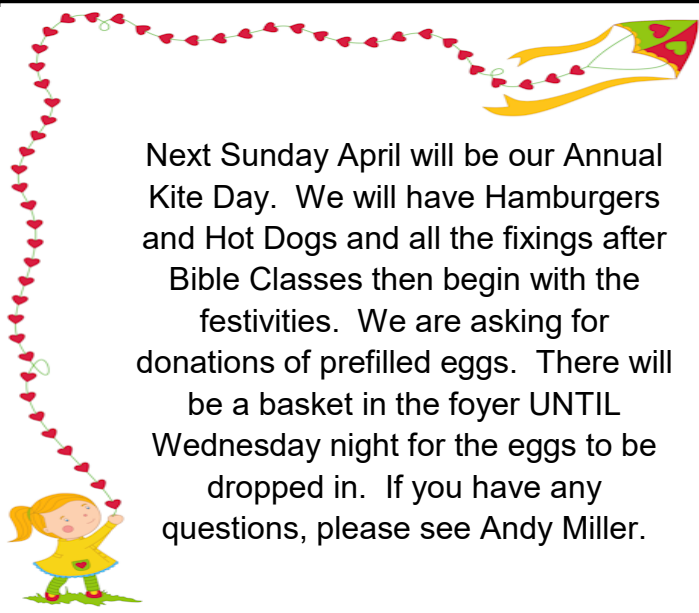


HELP NEEDED!!
