Bible Bowl Recap!

There were 491 teams (1,964 young people) from across several states. The following young people received medals for participating in Bible Bowl for 5 years: **Katherine Broome, David Heffington, Ben Meade and John Rhodes.** Aidan Broome received a plaque and was recognized as a Young Achiever for answering 75 questions correctly. We had 8 young people receive awards for their scores of 90 and above. These were: **Maddie Alden (92), Cayla Floyd (95), Chandler Floyd (98) and Kendell Hardison (99), McKenna Hardison (96), David Heffington (92), Kayla Reed (91) and Maridith Smith (93).** Kendell and Chandler placed 2nd and 3rd respectively for their scores. One of our Junior teams comprised of **Chandler Floyd, Kendell Hardison, McKenna Hardison and Kayla Reed,** was ranked 1st going into the "Sweet Sixteen" finals. At the end of the final round they won 2nd place overall. "SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

CHRIST IN COLOSSIANS

The focus of Colossians is on Christ, as is the focus of the entire Bible. Jesus is Lord of the universe and all things therein. (William Barclay called his commentary on Colossians "The Cosmic Christ.") The message of Colossians is relevant for both the church and the world. It proclaims Jesus as both Lord and Christ (Acts 2:36). It proclaims Him as Head of the church (Col. 1: 18). It insists that He must be worshipped and His word must be obeyed.

While Christ is mentioned throughout Colossians, the real focus on Him begins at Colossians 1:13. Verses 13-20 answer two very important questions about our Lord. (1) What Did Christ Do? (1: 13-14). (2) Who is Christ? (1: 15-20). This morning we will ask the first question and tonight the second one. If that seems to be in reverse order, it is. But we are following the text as it is written.

What did Christ do? Four things. (1) He delivered us. (2) He transferred us. (3) He redeemed us. (4) He forgave us. We will discuss each of these ideas this morning. Who is Christ? He is the Son of God (Mt. 16:16), the Lamb of God (Jn. 1:29), the Savior of the world (1 Jn. 4:14), the Son of Man who came to seek and save the lost (Lk. 19: 10).

What does Colossians 1:15-20 tell us about Jesus? (1) He is the image of the invisible God (1:15). (2) He is the firstborn over all creation (1:15). (3) By Him all things were created (1:16). (4) In Him all things consist (1:17). (5) He is the head of His church (1: 18). I hope you will be here for both lessons.
