Today is our monthly singing at NHC Nursing Home on Fairground St. in Franklin. It begins at 1:30 and everyone is invited!

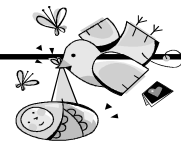
**Classroom Changes**

### "SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

## A NEW WARDROBE

The purpose of every Christian is to live like Christ and for Christ. Our lives are to glorify God (1 Cor. 10: 31). Christ lives within us (Col. 1:27) and controls us (Col. 3:17). The key to this idea is in Colossians 3:11, where Paul says that "Christ is all and in all." Christians have "put to death" the old man and "put on the new man" (Eph. 4: 22-24). The phrase "put to death" (Col. 3:5) is a strong term. It indicates the finality with which our lives have been changed by Christ. We are "dead to sin, but alive to God in Christ Jesus" (Rom. 6:11). Later Paul adds that we are to "put off" all of those things that are not Christian traits. The term "put off" means "once for all," as one puts off a piece of clothing, never to wear it again. We "have put off completely" the old life that we lived before Christ (Col. 3:9).

Conversely, we are to "put on" or clothe the new man or woman in the likeness of Christ. We are new people (Col. 3:10-11) who wear new clothes (Col. 3: 12-14). All of this produces powerful results in our lives. It impacts our hearts (Col. 3: 15), our worship (Col. 3:16), our lives (Col. 3:17) and our entire person (Col. 3:18 - 4:6). This means that Christ controls how we live as wives (Col. 3:18), husbands (Col. 3:19), children (Col. 3:20), fathers (Col. 3:21), servants (Col. 3: 22-25) and masters (Col. 4:1). In the final analysis, it means that Christ controls all of our lives (Col. 4:2-6).

That is why we say that Christians wear a new wardrobe.
