The Crucifixion of Christ

"And when they had come to the place called Calvary, there they crucified Him" (Lk. 23: 33). The blackest and saddest day in the history of the world was that day when they nailed our Lord to that old rugged cross on the hill outside Jerusalem called Calvary or Golgotha. And yet it was one of the two greatest days in the history of the world because that day and the day of His resurrection from the dead are the days of God's victory over sin and death.

In this morning's sermon we will remember those awful events that were a part of the crucifixion of Christ. This lesson, like the earlier ones in this series on the Final Week, will be taken primarily from the Gospel of Mark, with additions from the other gospel accounts where necessary. Basically the sermon is a narrative of those events that are included in the crucifixion of Jesus.

We will begin with the terrible treatment of our Lord by the Roman soldiers and end with the death of Jesus on the cross. Next week we will study the resurrection of Jesus. That lesson will begin with the burial of our Lord's lifeless body in the tomb of Joseph of Arimathea and end with His resurrection appearances.

These two events, the death and resurrection of Jesus, along with His burial, are the heart and core of the Christian gospel. (See 1 Corinthians 15: 1-8) Please open your Bible and study these most important events with us.
