"SERVICES FOR HEARING IMPAIRED"

~ Our Lord in Heaven ~

The Bible says that "Jesus Christ is Lord: (Phil. 2:11). He is "the Christ, the Son of the living God" (Mt. 16:16). The word "Christ" means Messiah, God's Anointed One. He is also "the Son of the living God." He was "declared with power to be the Son of God by the resurrection from the dead" (Rom. 1:4). He is our Savior (1 Jn. 4:14; Lk. 19: 10).

Where is our Lord? In heaven. Many centuries before Jesus was born, David prophesied that God said to our Lord, "Sit at My right hand, Till I make Your enemies Your footstool" (Ps. 110: 1). Jesus quoted this passage and applied it to Himself in Matt. 22: 41-45. (See Matthew 26: 63-64). Peter by inspiration applied the prophecy to Jesus in Acts 2: 33-36. The writer of Hebrews applies the prophecy to Jesus (Heb. 1: 13). Many New Testament passages speak of Jesus sitting at the right hand of God. (For example: Acts 5: 31; Acts 7: 55-56; Rom. 8: 34; Eph. 1: 20; Heb. 1: 3; Heb. 8: 1; Heb. 10: 12; Heb. 12: 2 and 1 Peter 3: 22).

What is our Lord doing in heaven? For one thing, He is interceding for us before God, as Isaiah prophesied He would (Is. 53: 12). To intercede is to come before God to make a petition, plea or appeal on our behalf. He "intercedes for us" (Rom. 8:34). "He always lives to make intercession for" us (Heb. 7: 25).

For another thing, He is our Advocate. "If anyone sins, we have an Advocate with the Father, Jesus Christ the righteous" (1 Jn. 2: 1). An Advocate is one who stands with us to plead our case. "We have one who speaks to the Father in our defense-Jesus Christ, the Righteous One" (NIV). As one writer observes, we are "not left in hopeless isolation." There is help for us "which reaches to the very top."
