# THE RESURRECTION

Over the last several Sundays we have studied the events that took place during the last week in the earthly life of Jesus. We have looked at His triumphal entry into Jerusalem, the controversies in the temple, the preparation for the Passover and its observance, and the betrayal, arrest and trials of our Lord. Last Sunday morning, in both the sermon and the Sunday School lesson, we reviewed what happened during His crucifixion. Today we will study the resurrection in both the sermon and the Bible School lesson.

Michael Green wrote, "The resurrection of Jesus Christ from the dead is the cornerstone of Christianity." George Eldon Ladd added that the resurrection "is the most important doctrine of the New Testament). Many other preachers, teachers, commentators and Bible scholars have confirmed this. And all faithful Christians throughout the centuries have agreed. God raised His Son from the dead. The tomb was empty.

Jesus repeatedly told His disciples that He would be crucified and raised from the dead. (See, for example, Mark 8: 31, 9: 31 and 10: 32-34). The prophets prophesied His death and resurrection (Isa. 53: 10; Dan. 7: 13-14). His resurrection from the dead declared that He is the Son of God (Rom. 1: 4). His resurrection confirms our resurrection (1 Corinthians 15). Our forgiveness of sins is based on His death on the cross. Our hope of eternal life is based on His resurrection. (See 1 Corinthians 15: 1-4)
